There are placement opportunities for you to complete your clinical practice hours within Mental Health, Learning Disabilities, General Practice, Community, Acute and Maternity environments. Apply now to one of the local NMC accredited universities for intake in 2020. The programme offers 6 study days and we will support you to access your chosen discipline within a clinical practice.
